



Attacking schools, shops, buses, restaurants and many other spaces.



With water and soap we wash our hands well. We must be clean to ring like a bell.




Say hello from afar and put on your face a smile. Let's left kisses and hugs apart for a while.




If you cough or sneeze, you should cover it with your elbow. You can also clean yourself with a napkin, though!
